Atorvastatin (generic name) Lipitor (brand name)	Common doses: 10, 20, 40, and 80 mg tablets Common regimen: One pill per day, every day.
	Side effects: muscle pain, nerve pain, slight risk of severe liver problems
	Cuts risks for cardiovascular events and strokes.
	Should not be taken by pregnant women, and is not considered safe for fetuses.
Rosuvastatin (generic name) Crestor (brand name)	Common doses: 15, 10, 20, and 40 mg. Common regimen: One pill per day, every day.
A third-generation statin	Side effects: nerve pain, long-term use brings risk of diabetes, higher risk of muscle problems than posed by atorvastatin or simvastatin. Lowers LDL levels. Raises HDL levels. Also
	reduces triglyceride levels



Other statins: Pravastatin (Pravachol), Fluvastatin (Lescol), Lovastatin (Mevacor), and Pitavastatin (Livalo)
